## Path to Better Buildings Workforce Guidelines

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and the National Institute of Building Sciences (NIBS) are engaging industry stakeholders to develop voluntary national guidelines that will improve the quality and consistency of commercial building workforce credentials for five key job titles: Building Energy Auditor, Building Commissioning Professional, Energy Manager, Building Operations Professional, Facility Manager (Government and FBPTA focus).
